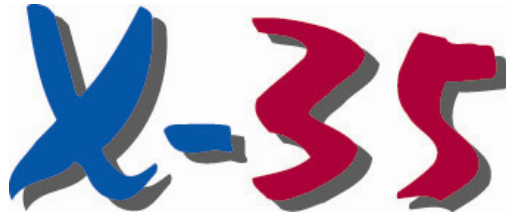

HULL:

X-35 International ONE DESIGN CLASS

Bottom treatment: Mat-sanding,
3 x epoxy/2 x antifouling
Flush mounted sea cocks
X-Yachts integrated steel girder frame

DECK:

Carbon spinnaker pole, and second (standard) spinnaker pole
4 Spectra sheets and guys
2 blocks on padeyes for sheets, 2 guy lead eyes
Pad eyes on rail for barberhaulers, pole downhaul led to both sides
In-hauler system for jib incl. blocks, pad eyes and cam cleats
Flush hull to deck joint for comfortable hiking (30mm toerail forward of mast)
Guard wire with padding, height set for improved hiking (conforms to ORC regs)
German Mainsheet System
Fredriksen Deck Gear
Wheel steering 150cm (cable system for weight saving)
Jackstays
Horseshow buoy
Auto inflatable Danbouy
Throw line
Boarding ladder Transom
Navigation lights, with spare bulbs on board
Cleat boots

MAST & RIGGING:

Newly designed by X-Yachts for improved stiffness and stability
Windex and steaming light. Single line reef system (1)
Masthead VHF antenna
Rod forestay, plastic foil with dual luff tracks, choker
Cunningham, Outhaul and Vang led back to both sides of coach roof.
Back stay: X-Yachts "Magic Wheel" system, ratio 1:45 as on IMX-40
